
Dear Parents,

Safe Internet User - February sees Internet Safety Day. We will be planning some sessions in school for the children, but I am delighted to invite you to a Parent Workshop being held with our partner school Threemilestone, at their school. It is being run by Police Sergeant Steve Shepherd - Law Enforcement Link for the UK Safer Internet Centre. This will be on the 6th March at 6pm. The session lasts approximately 90 minutes and covers things like current technology, games, threats, risks and harm and also resources so parents can assist their children in the digital world.
