





Buds Home Learning - Summer 2: Week 7 The Bog Baby

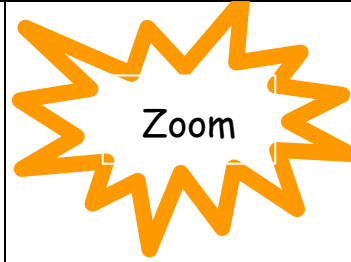
