As part of our Team Building studies, **Year 2** pupils will have the opportunity to visit Barstondale Activity Centre on **3rd February 2021**.

During the day the children will be taking part in The Wildwood Discover programme. Children will need to bring a packed lunch with them for the day and a water bottle with their name clearly marked. The children will be outdoors for most of the day and therefore they do not need to wear their school uniform. They should however wear appropriate clothing for outdoor activities. E.g. tracksuit, sensible shoes (these may get muddy) and a waterproof coat.

The total cost of the trip is **£24.00** per child. Due to Covid-19 restrictions we will require parents to drop their child(ren) at Barstondale Activity Centre between 9:00am and 9:15am where they will register and collect them from Barstondale at 3:10pm. Payment in full should be made via Parent Pay. Alternatively, you can pay smaller instalments as long as the full amount is paid by 8th January, 2021.
