Wise Use of Leisure

Following a chosen hobby for a minimum period of 6 months eg. Use of library, membership of uniformed organisation, learning to play a musical instrument.

The person leading the activity must sign for this, not parents or pupils.

Local Awareness

At Clatter level the local area project should be individually chosen by the Awardee. Some examples could be the study of a specific Wirral Area or Landmark or a Study of an organisation based on the Wirral.

This project can be supported by teachers and parents but must be completed independently (downloaded information straight from the Internet cannot be accepted)

Service to Others

Supporting a chosen charity by organising a sale of toys, homemade cakes etc.

Or

Collecting specific items required by the charity (eg. Blankets and dog food for an animal welfare group)

Physical Achievement

Personal progress in any chosen physical activity over a 6 month period. The progress needs to be demonstrated from Year 4, Birket. This needs to be signed preferably by a sports coach or someone who can explain the progress you have made.

Self-reliance

If possible Awardees should spend a night away from home and family.

Or

Take part in the Autumn term Year 5 bikeability programme in school. Your class teacher can complete and sign this section for you.
