

What if my child remains at **class action**?

If your child was not making the expected rate of progress in line with others receiving class action support, school would suggest the use of the Hillcrest Support Plan to set specific, measurable targets.

We would follow the cycle of assess, plan, do and review.

ASSESS: Meeting between staff and parent/SENDSCO may attend if advice is needed for next steps

Audit of actions already taken and progress made.



Expected outcome has not been reached and gap/s are not diminishing

PLAN: Look at the **Hillcrest Support Plan** and map out areas for development, actions to be taken and resources.



Hillcrest Support Plan will be written and shared with all involved with your child. A termly review meeting will be held to look at progress.



You will now be part of a cycle of **regular review** meetings in addition to parents evenings plus **1 x transition meeting**



Annually your child will write their One page profile, teachers will complete a Teacher's perspective and parents will complete a 'What you need to know' document. **It may be your child's Hillcrest Support Plan is in place for the next academic year.**



BUT, what if after rounds of reviews and targets, your child is falling further out of step with their age group?



Further investigation may be needed and so SENDSCO will have been attending your meetings and will make recommendations for next steps. For example, this could be referrals for speech assessment, psychology, occupational therapy.



Is this SEN? NO but specific action is being taken

Your child has additional educational needs which need further exploration before they can be determined to **be significantly complex.**
