Dear parents and carers,

Hello and welcome to our final term in Year 1. It is a jam-packed last seven weeks but it promises to be lots of fun.

We will continue to put all our writing and reading skills into learning about Norman castles and continue to work on phonics and spelling. We are looking forward to our trip to Chepstow Castle on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> June which will give us more inspiration for writing.

In maths, we will continue to work on the four operations, addition, subtraction, multiplication and sharing. We will be comparing, describing and solving practical problems for mass/weight [for example, heavy/light, heavier than, lighter than]; capacity and volume [for example, full/empty, more than, less than, half, half full, quarter]. We will learn about money and recognise and know the value of different denominations of coins and notes.

In Science the children will continue to work on their investigation skills, asking and answering scientific questions.

Please remember that we have PE on Mondays and Thursdays so the children must have their PE kits in on these days. Much of our PE will be outdoor this term, so please ensure that PE kit contains PE shoes (they may want to wear a cap and have a water bottle). Sports day is on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> June and we are hoping some of you will be able to accompany us on the walk to and from the cricket ground.

Our fortnightly homework tasks for English and Maths will continue. These will be posted on the school website on Tuesdays. The tasks are non-obligatory but we do celebrate any work that is brought in with the whole class.

July 3<sup>rd</sup> is transition day where the children will meet their Year 2 teacher. Parents will be invited in to meet and greet from 2.30 to 3.30 the same day.

The children will be taking part in their very first Hillcrest'o'Vision on Friday, July 13<sup>th</sup>. This is a whole-school singing contest. We will choose our class songs shortly.

We are hoping to organise a Year 1 picnic at Perrett's Park to celebrate a wonderful year. (details to follow).
