Dear Year 3 Parents/ Carers,

On **Monday 24th June 2019** we are planning on taking 3CS to visit Wrington Village Hall to find out about life on the Mendips, habitats and plants galore. We will leave school, by coach, at 9.00am and return at around 3.00pm.

We will start the day with an introduction to the ecology and history of the Mendips at Wrington Village Hall, then take the coach to Burrington Ham where the children will have a choice of activities, including map reading, mini den building, learning about the history of farming/human settlements and finding out about plants that grow on the Mendips that can be used for food and medicine.

We will head back to Wrington Village Hall to eat our lunch outside (weather permitting). We will round off our trip with any questions that the children have, and any further research they want to do.

The children will need to bring a packed lunch and a water bottle (no cans or glass bottles and no fizzy drinks please). They will need a waterproof outdoor coat, sunhat and suitable outdoor shoes. We will be outside most of the day, so please apply sun cream before coming into school.

The cost is £3.00 for each child, Please log onto school Gateway to pay by **Friday 14th June 2019**. Please note that this request is for a voluntary contribution and in no way represents a mandatory charge. No pupil registered at the school will be treated differently, whether or not their parents have made any contribution in response to the request.
