



My child has Covid-19 symptoms:

HIGH TEMPERATURE – this means they feel hot to touch on chest or back.

A NEW CONTINUOUS COUGH – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour or three or more coughing episodes in 24hrs.

A LOSS OR CHANGE TO SENSE OF SMELL OR TASTE – this means they've noticed they cannot smell or taste anything.

DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL

Inform the school.

GET A TEST

Self-isolate the WHOLE household while getting the child tested.

THE TEST IS NEGATIVE

Inform the school.

Return to school (if child is well)

**TEST IS POSITIVE
DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL**

Inform the school.

Quarantine the household for 14 days and the patient for at least 10 days.

CHILD THAT TESTED POSITIVE MAY RETURN TO SCHOOL when 10 days have passed and they feel better (as household has to quarantine for 14 days they may not be back until someone is able to bring them). Can return with a cough as this symptom can last for several weeks.

DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL

Inform the school.

GET A TEST

Self-isolate the WHOLE household while getting the person tested.

ISOLATING CHILD MAY RETURN TO SCHOOL after 14 days quarantine if neither they or anyone else in household has developed symptoms.

Someone in my household has Covid-19 symptoms.

DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL

Inform the school.

Quarantine the child at home for 14 days.

**DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL
Inform the school**

NHS Test & Trace has identified that my child has been in close contact with someone with confirmed Covid-19

RETURN TO SCHOOL when the school informs you that restrictions have been lifted.

We have been abroad and have been told we have to quarantine.

We have received medical advice that my child must resume shielding.

My child's school bubble is closed due to a Covid-19 outbreak in school

**DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL
Child should isolate for 14 days. School will support home learning.**
