Rocksteady Assembly Parents are invited to join us for a showcase of our school bands on Friday 23rd March at 9.15am in the school hall.

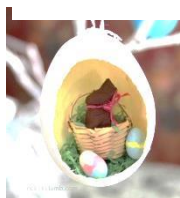
