

## Reading

Tips for helping your child to enjoy books:

- Visit the library as often as possible - take out CDs and DVDs as well as books.
- Schedule a regular time for reading - perhaps when you get home from school or just before bed.
- Buy dual-language books if English isn't your family's first language - you can talk about books and stories, and develop a love for them, in any language.
- Look for books on topics that you know your child is interested in - maybe dragons, insects, cookery or a certain sport.
- Make sure that children's books are easily accessible in different rooms around your house.

Practice 2, 5 and 10 times tables.

Read and write number to at least 100 in numbers and in words.

Recognise odd and even numbers.

Practice telling the time.

Recall addition facts to 20 fluently.

Add various coins and make different amounts.

Double and halve numbers to 20.

## Spellings

### HELPFUL TIPS FOR LEARNING SPELLINGS.

Look, Cover, Write, Check is a strategy used to help children learn their spellings.

A child is given a word to spell and:

- looks at it
- covers it over with a piece of paper or their hand
- writes the spelling again next to the word
- uncovers the spelling to check if they have got it right.

This is a good method to teach children so that they practise learning the spellings of words, but also so that they are testing themselves.
