Breakfast Club – A typical morning

Breakfast Club opens at 7.00am and offers children a healthy breakfast and fun activities before school. Our staff are experts at helping children settle in and enjoy the start to their day. In no time at all this will become a normal part of the morning routine for both you and your child.

As the start of the school day approaches, children gather their belongings, pop on a high-vis vest and are taken on our Minibus to Holy Trinity Primary School by our staff team. Once at school, our staff take the children to their classrooms, replicating you dropping them into school yourself. Should you have any messages for their class teacher, we can of course pass them on.

- You can drop off anytime from 7.00am to when school starts, giving the flexibility to suit your schedule

After School Club – A typical afternoon

After School Club opens straight after school and closes at 6.30pm. Children enjoy a healthy dinner and fun activities until you come to collect them. Our staff are experts at helping children settle in and enjoy their afternoon activities. In no time at all this will become a normal part of the after school routine for both you and your child.

At the end of the school day, our staff are on hand to collect Reception children from their classrooms and gather them together with the other children going back to club. After popping on a high-vis vest, the children then travel the short distance on our Minibus to The Albemarle Centre, on the Oathall Community College school site. Once at Club, children pop their coats and bags away, grab a snack and a drink and begin to play. Should their teacher have any messages for you, we will of course pass them on.

Children then have a variety of activities to choose from throughout the afternoon, with our staff providing a blend of structured, planned activities and plenty of opportunities to play.

Midway through the session, children have their tea together – a real social highlight of every club. Children then continue to play (often outside) until you arrive to collect. Our greatest complement comes when children don't want to go home as they're having too much fun!
