Nursery – Outdoor Learning

Despite the wet weather the Nursery children had a great time outside for the day on Tuesday. We made bubble puddles sweeping and jumping in them. The children helped to collect and transport and put some more sand in the outdoor sandpit. They used their muscles to dig and carry wheelbarrows full of sand. We painted large cardboard pieces and large pebbles that we found. We had read the rhyming story 'This is the Bear' and 'The Picnic Lunch' so the children were making picnics in the mud kitchen and sandpit. The children decided to make a pirate ship with the large building blocks and then pretended the climbing frame was a ship and drew fishes and sharks in the water using chalks on the ground. We had fun with playdough making shapes and letters. They enjoyed throwing bean bags at the letter sounds on the shed seeing if they could hit the correct sound the adult shouted out. Some children decided to help Mrs Smith make the fire by screwing up newspaper and then enjoyed singing songs and playing instruments. We sat with our blankets around the fire and drank hot chocolate and had our snack. It was great fun.



Rules of Divisibility

This week Year 5 pupils were investigating the rules of divisibility. They had to find a missing number that did not fit any of the rules. Everyone worked together to check the numbers were placed carefully in the Venn diagrams. We had to think carefully about which multiples were divisible by two numbers.



Cooking

The children in Reception have been taking it in turns to do cooking every Friday. Each week a group of children plan what they would like to cook, check what ingredients they need and make a shopping list. They then visit the local shop to buy the ingredients before doing their cooking. This gives the children experience of weighing, measuring and handling money. This term's favourite recipe is chocolate chip cookies!
