On Monday we had a visit from the Police officers and they brought their Police van.

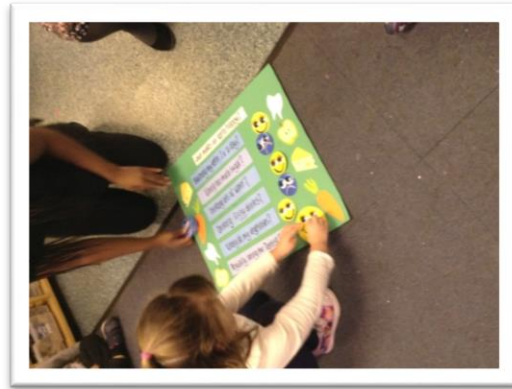

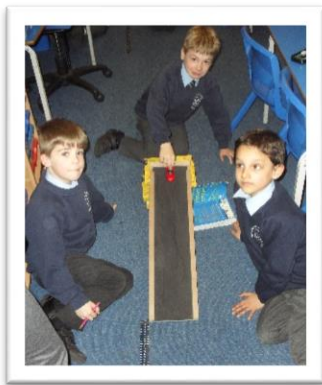


World Book Day in the snow

Year 3 Science

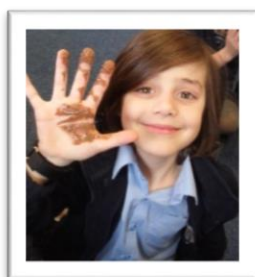


Year 3 pupils have been investigating friction. They used slopes and cars to find out the how changing the angle and surface of the slope affected the distance the cars travelled.
