TOGETHER WE ACHIEVE

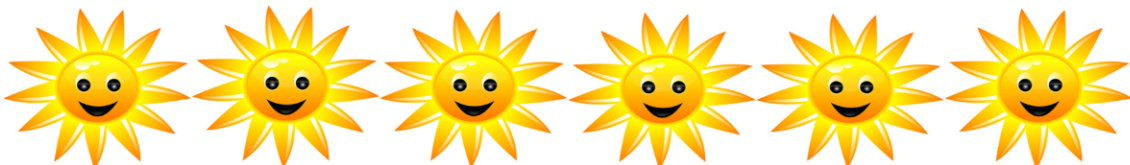
As this academic year draws to a close, I would like to express my thanks once again to the community of Barlby for the tremendous support shown towards the school during the unprecedented and difficult last 16 months. To the wider community and charities that have provided school with support, initiatives and gifts for the children. To you the parents and families that have adapted your whole lives to fit around bubble closure, national lockdowns and school closures at very short notice but still managed to support your children's education and the array of activities we have thrown at you. To the Governors that have been with the staff every step of the way offering support and feedback, encouragement and recognition for the work in school. And, to the children who have adapted, smiled, made us laugh and persevered against the odds. They are a real credit to the whole community.

However, I would like to focus my thanks in this last newsletter to the amazing team we have working in school.

Over the last 16 months we have asked staff to work through a pandemic with ever changing rules, guidance and advice, with their own personal fears and worries running alongside. Within school, staff have produced home learning packs, video lessons and support packs for every child in school within 24 hours. We have asked staff to pick up extra cleaning, knowing that they are increasing their own risk of catching the virus. Staff have changed their working patterns to meet the childcare needs for the key workers, in the first lockdown offering care to children from across Selby 7 days a week from 7am until 7pm right through their own holiday periods. Staff have provided catch up programmes, booster classes and individual tutoring, done doorstep visits, delivered learning packs and food hampers. As lockdowns have eased staff have worked tirelessly to try and bring some normality back to the children's lives, organising swimming opportunities, day trips, residentials and school clubs, some we have managed to see through others have been cancelled at the last minute, but the staff continued to organise enrichment activities against the odds. Staff have put their own families at risk to ensure they can meet the needs of the children that have attend school throughout the past 16 months and those that have needed support at home. Many parents have sent emails to thank class teachers and support staff and we are grateful for every single one of them. We could not have asked for more from the team within school, I send my personal thanks to all the staff, whatever their role, for making Barlby Primary School the community school that it is.

I wish you all a wonderful summer break, some well-deserved freedom and family time and look forward to a hint of normality when we all return on Tuesday 7th September.
