On Monday 26th March there will be a transition session after school at Helston Community College for Y5 pupils.



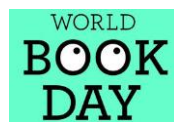
Cross Country League

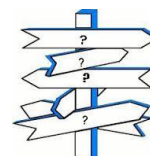
