### **Swimming - Spring Term 2020**

Children in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 will be having swimming lessons as part of the PE curriculum for 10 sessions in the Spring term. The sessions will be on Thursdays from 13:30 to 14:30 and will begin on Thursday 16 January 2020.

The school funds the hire of the pool and tuition costs of two swimming coaches (£121.30 per session, total cost £1,213.00). The total number of pupils in these year groups is 42, which means that it is not feasible to transport using the school minibus; we will have to hire a bus for these sessions at a cost of £125 a trip. Therefore we are asking parents to contribute towards the cost of coach travel to and from the pool at Helston. The cost of the coach will be £3.00 per child per session and there will be 10 sessions altogether, so the total payment will be £30.00. The preferred payment method is ParentPay, so please ensure you have activated your account; alternatively you may pay by cash or cheque made payable to Southerly Point Co-operative MAT. (Please let us know if you require a reprint of your ParentPay activation letter.)

In arriving at the costing for the transport, we assume children will attend all 10 sessions, unfortunately, unless sessions are missed due to a long term illness, we will have to charge for odd absences in order that the cost of the transport is met.

Please would you complete the attached reply slip and return to school by Tuesday 14 January.
