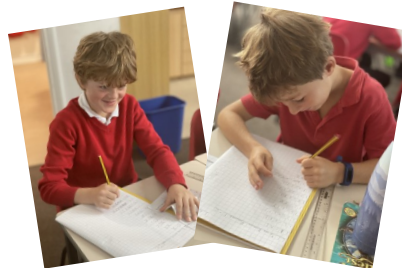

Pupil Premium

Have your personal circumstances changed?
Are you unemployed, long term sick or a single parent?
If you are in receipt of any of the following :-

- Universal credit (provided you have a net income of £7,400 or less)
- Income support
- Income-based job seeker allowance
- Support under Part IV of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of state pension credit
- Child tax credit, provided that you are not also entitled to working tax credit and have an annual gross income of £16,190 or less

you may be entitled to Pupil Premium support. This does NOT affect any of your benefits but allows the school to access extra funding for your child, to support them with visits and any curriculum needs they may have. It also entitles them to a free school meal which you may or may not wish to take up. Please contact Mrs Fitzgerald or follow the link below if you think you may be eligible:
