

<b>Milestones</b>	There are three milestones across the Primary age range. At the Junior school, we are teaching Milestone 2 (Y3/4) and Milestone 3 (Y5/6)
<b>Subject Areas</b>	Your child's current achievements in <b>Writing, Reading and Maths</b> have been shared in detail with you at the consultation.
<b>Learning Objectives</b>	Each of these subjects is assessed against a set of learning objectives which <b>remain the same</b> throughout the milestones (see bar chart below).
<b>Key Indicators</b>	There are key indicators for each learning objective in each milestone which can be achieved in increasing depth. <a href="#">Click here</a> for the detailed assessment criteria on the website. This will help you support your child to achieve their target.
<b>Basic/Advancing/Deep</b>	Your child will demonstrate increasing depth of learning at each of these key indicators as they progress through their milestone. All children begin a milestone (Y3 and Y5) at a Basic level. Each depth of learning measure (Basic/Advancing/Deep) is split into two levels based on achieving some, most or all of the key indicators respectively: 1=Some evidence      2= Widespread evidence
<b>Age appropriate standard</b>	Reaching an ' <b>Advancing 2</b> ' depth of learning by the <b>end of the milestone</b> will ensure an age appropriate level. Some children will demonstrate learning at a 'deep' level and others still at a 'basic' level.
<b>Pebbles</b>	Some children will be working below the age-appropriate indicators within their milestone and will most likely have other types of information shared regarding their achievement. Some or all of the achievements made by these children will be measured in smaller progress steps that precede milestones. These are referred to as 'pebbles'.

Your child's teacher will have shared your child's current 'depth of learning' in Writing, Reading and Maths with you at the consultation. There will also be an opportunity to discuss other areas of learning and your child's attitude to their studies too. Please be aware that this information shows attainment so far this year. Not all the curriculum has been taught yet from the year, nor from the milestone. As the year progresses, we will be able to make a fuller assessment of your child's 'depth of learning' and share a greater level of detail with you about tracking and progress towards end of both milestone and key stage outcomes.
