Nature of Support

- Additional Teaching Assistant support for individuals in reading.
- Boosters for Maths in Years 5 and 6.
- Coaching in Maths for teachers.
- Coaching in Literacy for teachers.
- Additional in-school provision for parent and family support
- Small group support to develop able writers in KS1
- Small group support to develop reading comprehension skills in Years 5 and 6
- Small group support for writing in KS2
- When appropriate, financial support to pupils whose circumstances are challenging so they can participate in extra school activities

Impact

- In maths at the end of KS2 94% of pupils made 2 levels of progress and 24% made more than expected progress
- In writing at the end of KS2 97% of pupils made 2 levels of progress and 24% made more than expected progress
- In reading at the end of KS2 94% of pupils made 2 levels of progress and 22% made more than expected
- In reading, writing and maths at the end of KS2 all pupil premium children made at least expected progress
- All pupil premium children in KS1 made expected age related progress in reading
- Extra curricular activities helped children to improve self-esteem, confidence, social skills and to be more involved in physical activities
- Increased parental engagement through support for families allowing children to settle successfully into school
