Nature of Support

- Additional Teaching Assistant support for individuals in reading
- Additional Teaching Assistant for small group support in phonics
- Boosters for maths in Year 5 and 6
- Coaching in maths for teachers
- Purchase of maths resources
- Additional in-school provision for parent and family support
- Developing a nurture room (rainbow room)
- When appropriate, financial support to pupils whose circumstances are challenging so they can participate in extra school activities

Impact

- In reading and writing at the end of KS2 all pupil premium children made 2 level progress in reading and writing.
- In maths 3 out of 4 pupil premium children achieved and exceeded 2 levels of progress
- Extra phonics support in KS1 resulted in 89% achieving the required standard in phonics for the end of Year 1.
- Overall in at KS1 95% of pupils achieved or exceeded the national average in maths
- Extra curricular activities enabled individuals to take part in greater percentage of physical exercise, develop social skills and improve self esteem
- Our nurture room is supporting the emotional well being of our children
- In-school parental support has helped to increase parental engagement for specific families and has meant children are more settled in school and supported at home
