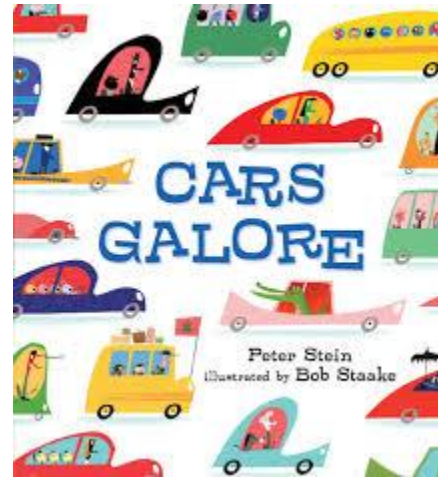


Owlets Learning Journey - Spring Term.

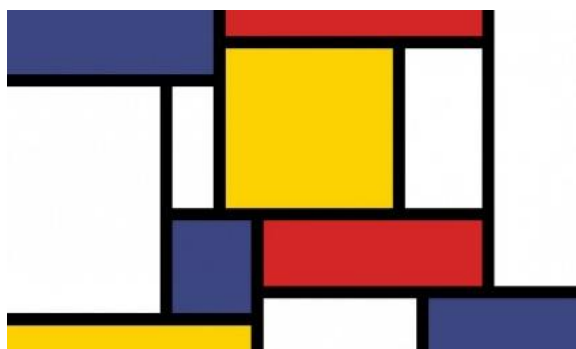
Curious about Cars.
