Start of the School Day

There has been a marked increase in the number of children arriving late to school in the mornings, coupled with late items being brought into school after children have arrived.

Pupils are expected to be into school by 8:55 a.m., after which all outer doors are closed and pupils need to come in via the front of the school to be signed in. Whilst we understand that there are always unforeseen circumstances which results in late arrivals, we would like to ask for your co-operation in getting your child/ren into school promptly. Please be reminded that children should not be on site unaccompanied before 8.45 a.m.

Please note that any child arriving late must be signed in by an accompanying parent/carer and must not come into school late on their own. We operate the signing in screen as an additional safeguarding level for pupils and can only monitor late pupils when they come through the front office. We are unable to track late pupils when they go directly to class without signing in first.

When preparing your child/ren for school each day, please could we ask that they come into school with all the necessary equipment they may need, i.e. P.E. kits, homework, lunch bags etc. Whilst the school makes every effort to get these late items reunited with their owners it does become onerous when in excess of 15 items can come in each day. We do feel those child/ren are more settled to start their day if they know they have everything with them that they need.

PE News

The Sports Ambassadors met with the new Committee last week to discuss how active each class is. Every class has a committee member who will feed back to their class about sporting opportunities and ideas that we have discussed whilst also helping to raise the profile of PE further within our school.

Finally a gentle reminder, earrings must be removed completely for a PE lesson. If your child has had their ears pierced recently then the earrings can remain in and the Teacher will amend the lesson for your child.
