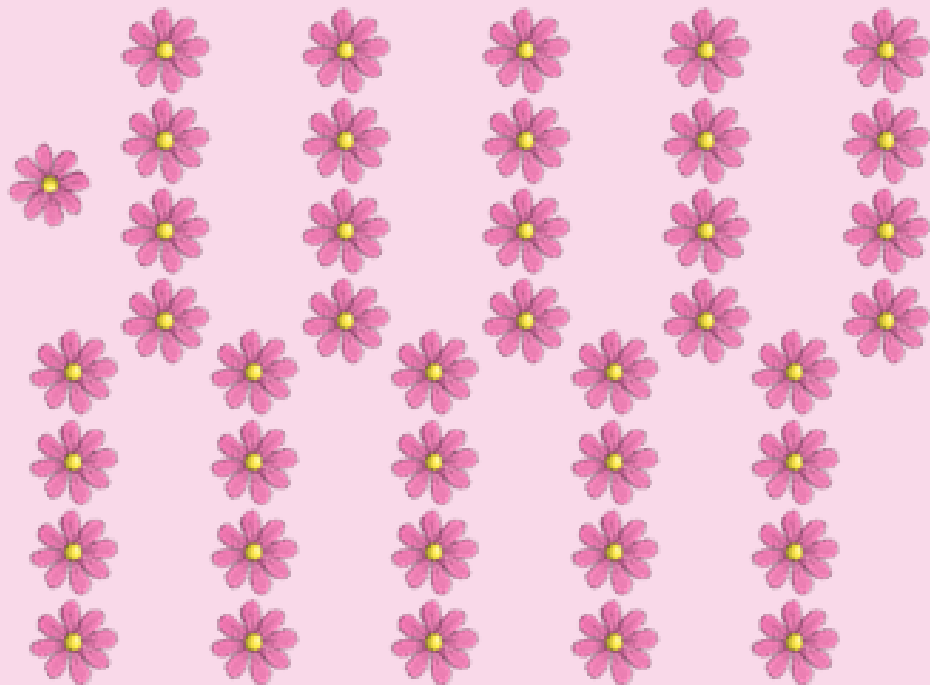

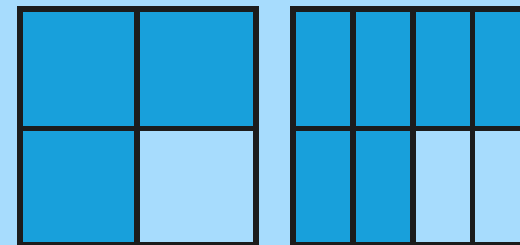
What are the next three numbers in this sequence?
