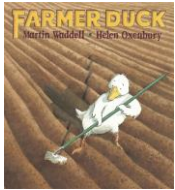


Personal, Social & Emotional Development

- Getting to know each other and making friends
- Developing confidence
- Following routines.

Communication, Language and Literacy

- Speaking and Listening - sharing treasure boxes, developing talk partners.
- Mark making, handwriting patterns
- Develop 'have a go' writing
- Hearing rhyme and alliteration
- Join in with rhymes and stories
- Recognising name and learning to write name
- Listening to stories with familiar settings, identifying characters in stories

Mathematics

- Number rhymes and songs
- Identifying numbers at own level
- Counting, sorting, counting objects accurately, comparing numbers
- Language of size eg big, tall, smaller, smallest
- Identifying and copying patterns
- Identifying shapes, using them to make pictures, using appropriate vocabulary to describe shapes



Understanding the World

- Becoming familiar with the school environment
- Talking and learning about people who help us at school and in our local community.
- Learning about farm animals.
- Seasonal changes - autumn
- Computing - using painting programs on the computer
- Using remote control toys
- Using digital cameras

Physical Development
