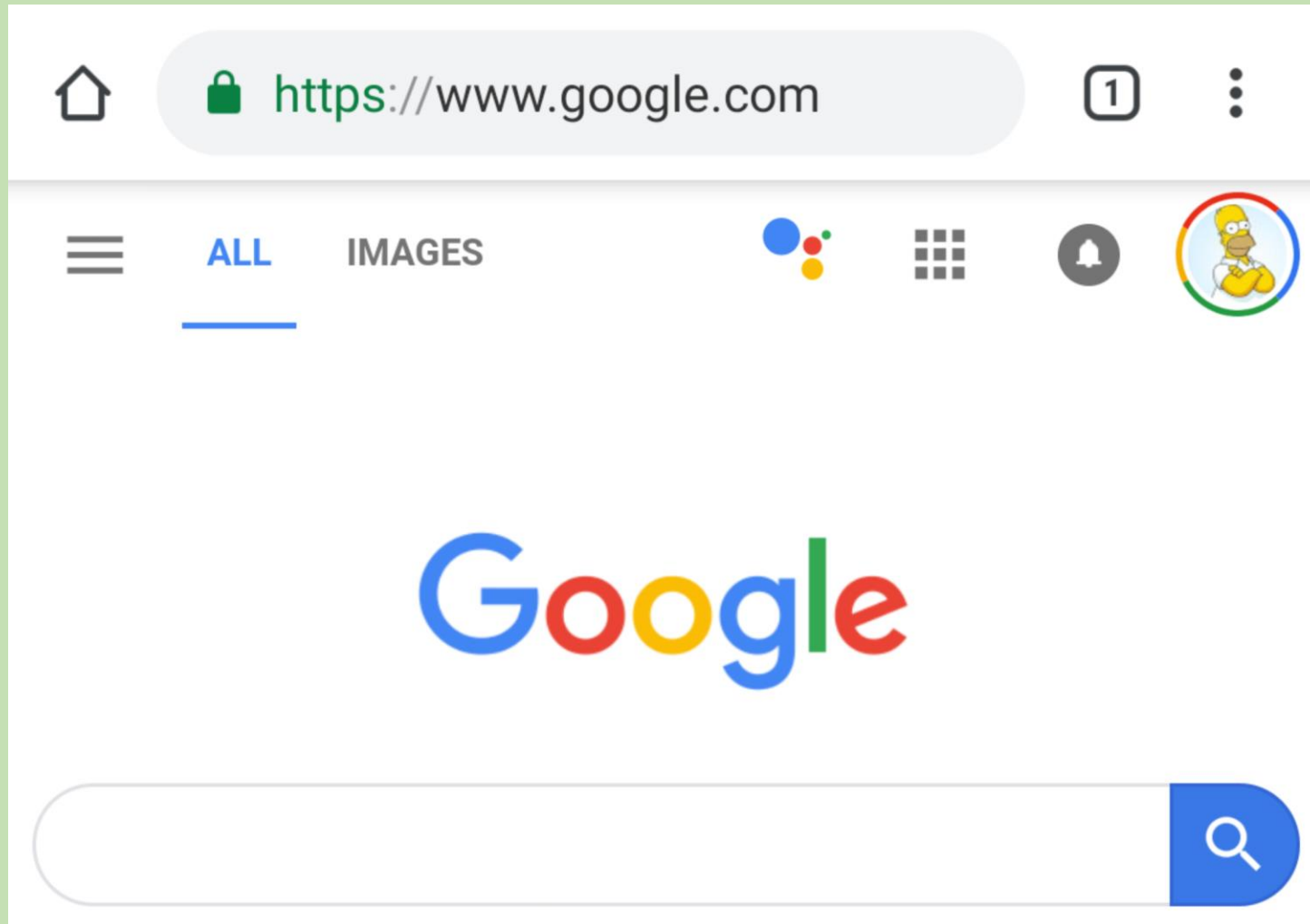

1. Can you open a new word document and the internet page?



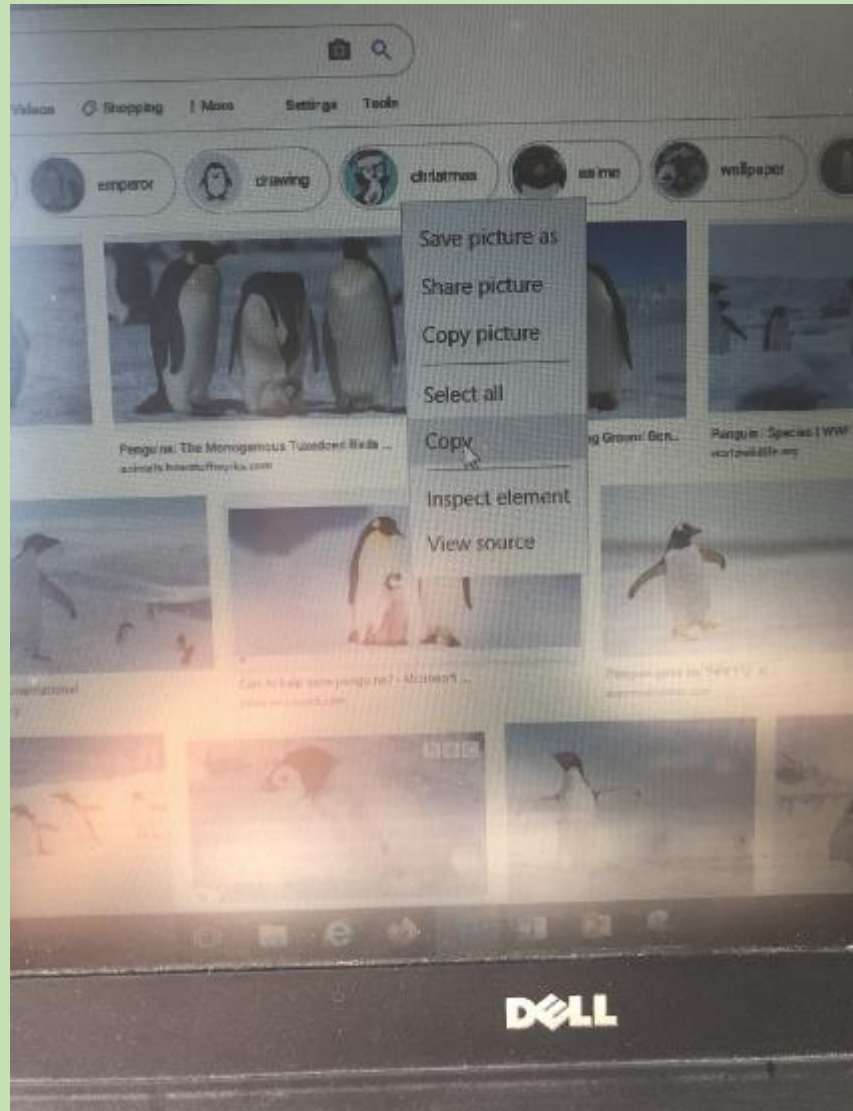
2. Can you search google for an animal you like and select images?

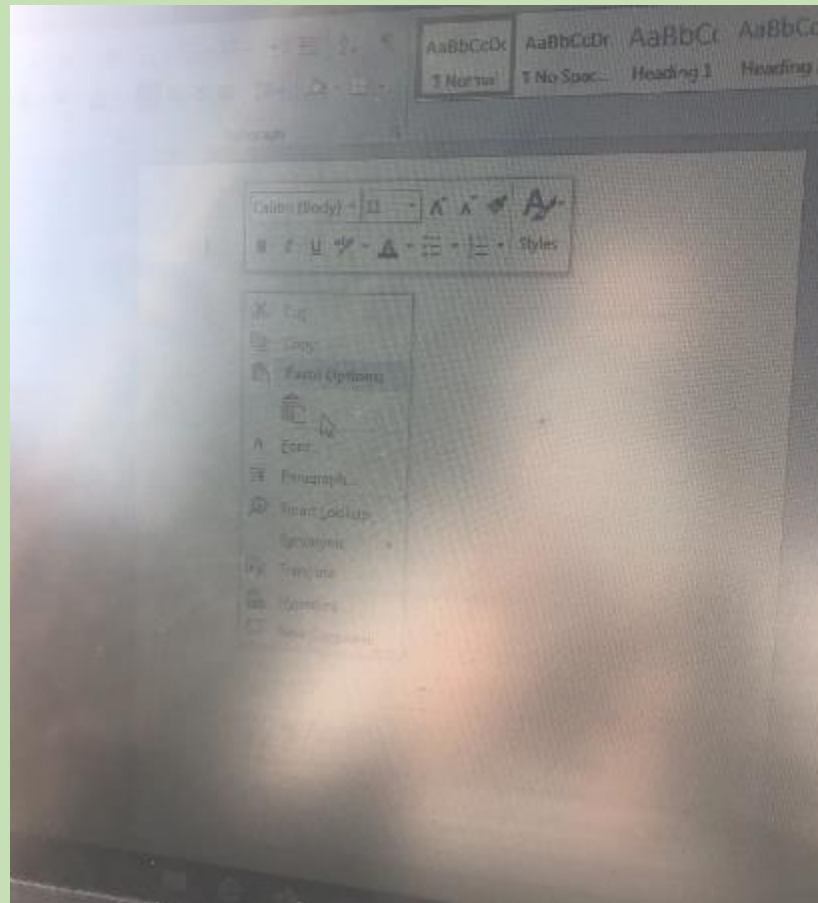
