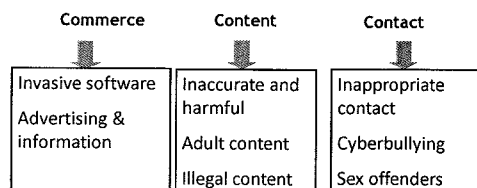

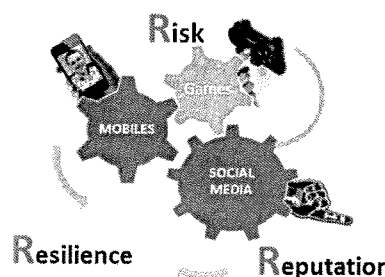
Potential risks

- ★ Grooming
- ★ Mobile devices
- ★ Privacy/Data protection (biometrics)
- ★ Data transfer
- ★ Hacking
- ★ Viruses/malware
- ★ Identity theft
- ★ Internet safety

Mobile phones

- ★ bluetooth facility (bluejack)
- ★ 24 hour bullying
