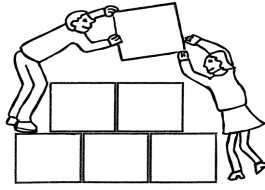

Dear Parent/Carer

This letter is to inform you that a student in the school has a as a severe food allergy to peanuts. It is important that there is strict avoidance to this food in order to prevent a life-threatening allergic reaction.

We are asking your help to provide the student with a safe school environment. Any exposure to peanuts may cause a life-threatening allergic reaction that may require emergency medical treatment. To reduce the chance of this occurring, we are asking that you do not send any peanut containing products to school with your child.

If your child has eaten peanuts before coming to school, please be sure your child's hands and face have been thoroughly washed before entering the school. We appreciate your support with these procedures. To make this clear, we are asking for the school to be a peanut free zone. This means that other types of nuts are acceptable. For example, Nutella as a sandwich spread doesn't contain peanuts. If you have a query about a particular food item then please ask at the office. However, it is always better to be on the safe side and not to send an item to school if you are unsure whether it is acceptable or not.
