The Tigers Class had a very exciting day on Wednesday as part of their transport topic they had a visit from the fire service who brought along one of their fire engines.



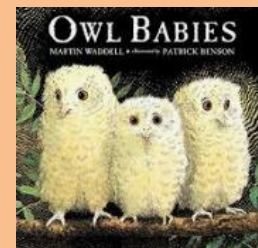

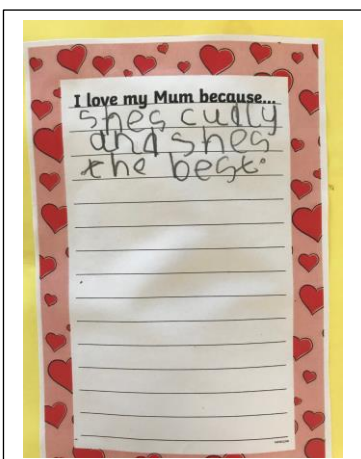
