Outcomes to date: Babcock Excellence in PE support package has provided support to teaching staff in planning quality Physical Education lessons. Staff have been skilled up in various activities. Sensory area has been developed to support group and individual work with children to improve their social, emotional and mental health. Children more active at lunchtimes and playtimes using Tyre Park as an additional activity. Being a fixed safe outdoor play activity the Tyre Park has been used to improve balance, co-ordination and increase confidence. Orienteering resources and maps used around the school grounds enabling children to learn navigational skills. Children learn to move from point to point and access and investigate all outdoor areas of the school.
