<p><u>English</u></p> <p>In term 3 we will be focusing on fantasy story writing. This will cover many elements of spelling, punctuation and grammar such as figurative language, adverbs, prepositions, adjectives, senses and emotions.</p>	<p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>In term 3 we will be focusing on multiplication and division. This involves knowing how to multiply and divide by 10 and 100, knowing our times tables up to 12 x 12, and written methods of division and multiplication up 2 digits by 1 digit.</p>	<p><u>D.T</u></p> <p>We will be making our very own pop books which will include our fantasy stories closely linked to The Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe.</p>	<p><u>Science</u></p> <p>Changing states will be our learning focus this term. This looks into solids, liquids and gasses. We will conduct several investigations led by the children's own questions.</p>
<p><u>Reading</u></p> <p>Our class text is the C.S. Lewis classic, The Lion, The witch and The Wardrobe.</p> <p>In reading lessons, we will study a range of fiction which will help build up our vocabulary as well as our awareness of our audience.</p>	<p><u>P.E</u></p> <p>In term 3 we will be focusing on the 'cognitive' aspect of being a good sportsperson. We teach a range of skills, practise them and then try to transfer these skills into a range of games. We will continue with daily active learning with our move it spellings, jump start Jonny and sports hall lessons.</p>	<p><u>Drama</u></p> <p>We will be rehearsing for our performance of the Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe this term.</p>	<p><u>Spelling</u></p> <p>This term will be looking at a range of prefixes and statutory spelling words in our daily spelling sessions.</p>
