

## MORE SPELLING ACTIVITIES

<b>WORDS WITHOUT VOWELS</b>	Write spelling words in a list, replace all vowels with a line. Then go back to beginning and see if you can fill in correct vowels.
<b>WORDS WITHOUT CONSONANTS</b>	Write spelling words in a list, replace all consonants with a line. Then go back to beginning and see if you can fill in correct consonants.
<b>SPELLING FLASHCARDS</b>	Make a set of flashcards to practise your spelling words.
<b>SPELLING POEM</b>	Write a poem using as many of your spelling words as possible. <u>Underline</u> your words.
<b>WORDS WITHIN WORDS</b>	Write each spelling word and then write at least two words made from the same letters that is hidden inside the word.
<b>SPELLING FLOWERS</b>	Draw a big flower. Write your words on petals or leaf.
<b>RHYMING WORDS</b>	Write each word. Next to each word write a rhyming word.
<b>SQUIGGLY SPELLING</b>	Write words, then write in squiggly letters.
<b>THREE TIMES</b>	Write words three times, once in pencil, once in coloured crayon and then once in felt tip.
<b>OUTLINE SHAPE</b>	Draw a large shape and then write spelling words around the edge of the shape.
<b>DOT-TO-DOT</b>	Write some of you spelling words in dots and then connect the dots with a pencil.
<b>PYRAMID WRITING</b>	Pyramid write your words.
