

Art and Design	Key Skills
Art/DT activities linked to our topic on the Romans including Mosaics and clay modelling	I can use my knowledge of life in Roman Britain to create mosaics and drawings that reflect this period of history.

History	Key Skills
The Romans in Britain: Looking at forts, towns and roads as well as the life of a gladiator and how the Romans spent their leisure time. A visit to a local Roman site/museum.	I can use knowledge from my research to understand and write about life in Roman Britain. I can explain how the lives of wealthy people were different from the lives of poorer people.

Science	Key Skills
Woodpeckers will study all aspects of sounds - identifying how sounds are made, how sound travels and how sound patterns are made.	I can associate sounds with something vibrating. I can recognise vibrations from sound that travel through to an ear. I can recognise that sounds get fainter as the distances from the sound source increases.

Computing	Key Skills
Woodpeckers will : * develop a simple educational game. * design a prototype toy. * become HTML editors	I can get ideas from other educational websites for games. I can develop a simple educational game. I can understand how the internet works and link to other websites.

Year 4 – Autumn Term 2

‘Ancient Rome’

Subjects and skills

English
Year 4 follow the National Curriculum for English focussing on spoken language, reading and writing. We work to the Year 4 expectations of spelling, vocabulary and grammar. We will focus, for example, on the correct spelling for homophone words. We will look at complete stories and extracts from fairy stories, myths and legends. We will also look at newspaper article writing as a cross curricular activity with our history topic on the Romans.

Maths
We follow the National Curriculum Year 4 Programme of Study in Maths. Units include: Multiplication and division facts for multiplication tables up to 12. Fractions: recognise and show, using diagrams, families of common equivalent fractions, solve simple money problems involving fractions and decimals to 2 decimal places.
