

Pupil Premium



The Government provides schools with additional funding to help certain children do their very best

If your child registers for Pupil Premium, they will also receive subsidised school trips.



Pupil Premium is an important source of funding for our School. It helps to support many of the children who we work with.

Do you receive?

- Universal Credit with an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guarantee element of Pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit run on (paid for the 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190



If so your child can be registered for Pupil Premium.

All children in Reception and Key Stage One are entitled to a free school lunch under the Universal Free School Meals Scheme, but only those registered as entitled to Free School Meals will receive the additional Pupil Premium support.
So it is really important that you register.

Registering is really quick and easy, please complete and return the Application for Free School Meals form available from in your pack.

No one will know you have registered and it will not affect any other benefits you may be claiming.

Pupils who are classed as Looked After (adopted from care, Looked After by Social Services) and children from service families also qualify for schools to receive additional funding. Please ensure you record this on your child's admission form.
