

Sewn in or stick in labels are best as pen often becomes illegible.</p> <p>A few items have been misplaced and mixed up this week, and it is very difficult to reunite items with their owners when there aren't labels on them.</p> <p>Please ensure coats, hats, gloves and scarves are labelled too as well as school uniform as we head in to the winter months.</p>	<p>As a school that promotes healthy living and lifestyles, we bring to your attention the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Please provide a bottle of water daily for your child to drink throughout the day to keep hydrated. We ask that you do <u>not</u> send in bottles filled with juice. • We ask that the number of sweets and chocolate is limited in your child's packed lunches. • Please provide a spoon from home if your child has a yoghurt in their packed lunch. • Our pupils in Reception, Years 1 and 2 have free fruit each day as part of our healthy snack programme.
