Due to our school closure, as directed, you are asked to complete the following tasks, as best you can on a daily basis:

<b>Reading for Pleasure</b>	Read as much and as often as you can whether it be your reading book or books you have at home. Please make sure you keep a log of your reading in your red reading record.
<b>Online Reading</b>	Access Read Theory activities for 15-20 minutes each day using your login details. This will help you keep on track with your reading, boost your comprehension skills and improve your vocabulary!
<b>Writing</b>	<p>Create a fictitious diary to keep a log of what your characters/s get up to. Make it as exciting and adventurous as you can. A pencil and some paper has been provided for you.</p> <p>Why not watch clips on CBBC Newsround to give you some ideas?</p>
<b>Spelling</b>	Access a Spelling Shed activity for 10-15 minutes each day using your login details. Targeted spelling rules will be updated weekly.
