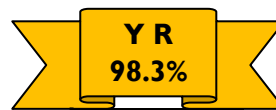

Allergies & Choking	Year 6 Transfer	Harvest Festival
<p>We have an increasing number of children in our school with nut allergies. We ask that parents/carers are mindful of this when sending in snacks and packed lunch goods that may contain nuts. <u>Please do not send any form of nuts into school as a snack to help protect of pupils with allergies and avoid potential choking risks.</u> Thank you for your support with this matter as the wellbeing of our pupils is our number one priority. We also ask that for any children having fruit as a snack or part of their packed lunch sent in from home that they must be cut up into smaller, manageable pieces before they come into school. This includes snacks such as strawberries, apples, kiwi, grapes and tomatoes. This will help to avoid any potential choking risks.</p>	<p>The Year 6 secondary school application deadline is fast approaching.
