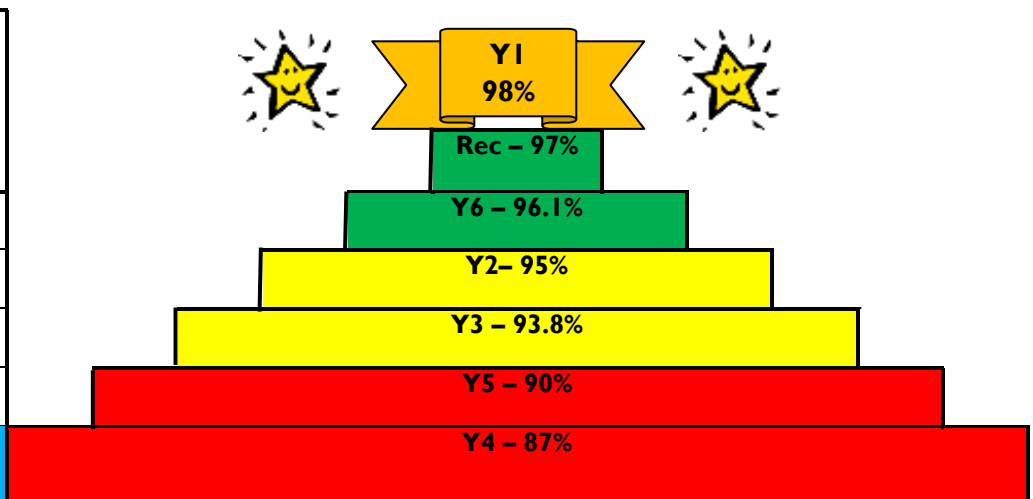

Pupils will be supervised by school staff during the walk however parents/carers are welcome to walk with the parish if they wish to do so. Please let staff know if you are taking your child at the end of the walk from Warrington town centre or they are to return to school on the bus. We will be hosting discos for all of our pupils to celebrate as we approach the end of term and raise money for school funds.</p> <p>Disco for Reception. Years 1 and 2 will take place from 3.00-4.30pm. Pupils will need to buy a ticket from the school office at a cost of £4.00 which will include admission to the disco, a hotdog, crisps and drinks. Pupils in Reception, Years 1 and 2 may wear their own clothes to school that day. Pupils need to be collected from the walkway entrance at 4.30pm.</p> <p>Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 will have their disco from 5.00-6.30pm. As above, tickets are £4.00. <p>Warrington Borough Council have sent home a form with information on about changes to our school meals for children in our current Reception and Year 1 classes. The changes will come into effect as of September.</p> <p>Pupils in these classes are entitled to a free school meal. From September, WBC are asking families to opt in for a school meal each day for one term at a time. So if you sign up in September for your child to have a free dinner then they are now expected to have a meal each day until the end of December.</p> <p>There is not an option to change between packed lunch or hot dinner. Changes can only be made at the beginning of a new term.</p>	<p>Accompanying today's newsletter is our new monthly Internet safety newsletter.</p> <p>This monthly issue will give you information and ideas to share with your children.
