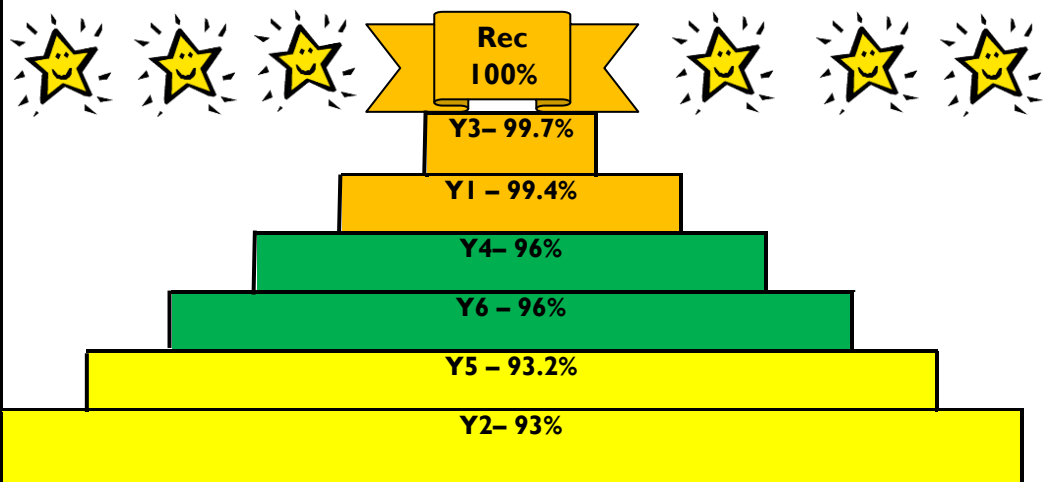

Hopefully you will find these useful when chatting to your child about their school day and their learning. The information sheets are published on the school app and on the school website under the 'Curriculum' tab. Just click on your child's year group to access the necessary information.</p>	<p>Thank you to those parents/carers who joined Mr Glynn and Mrs Butterworth for the information meeting about the planned trip to the Kingswood Centre, Colomendy in September 2020. We were delighted with the facilities, activities and organisation of this year's trip and we are certain that Y5 will love it just as much when they visit at the beginning of Y6.</p> <p>A letter has been sent home today with a consent section and information about the payment plan and deadlines. The first deposit is due by 14<sup>th</sup> February. We have to stick to the payment guidelines as the Kingswood Centre set the payment plan but if you have any questions about the trip or payment, please see Mr Glynn or Mr Hatton for further help.</p>	<p>As part of our reading policy, pupils are expected to read for at least 10 minutes each night and parents/carers are asked to note, sign and date that their child's has read. Reading books and reading records should be returned to school each day. Research has proven that regular reading at an early age boosts confidence, vocabulary and helps develop creativity and imagination in a child's writing. Support at home is vital and much appreciated. We know that family time is important too so if a child is unable to read at home, we offer KS2 pupils a chance to catch up on their reading at break time in school so as not to break their reading routines. This is supervised by Mrs Georgiou, our Reading Lead.</p>

## REMINDERS:

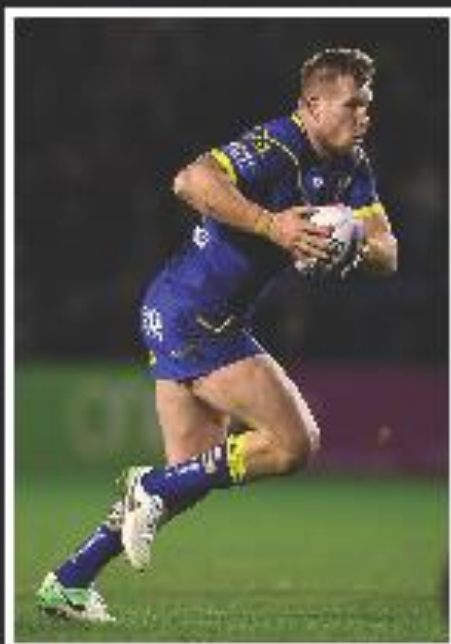
- Year 5 Come and See Assembly – Friday 31<sup>st</sup> January at 2.30pm in the Hall.
