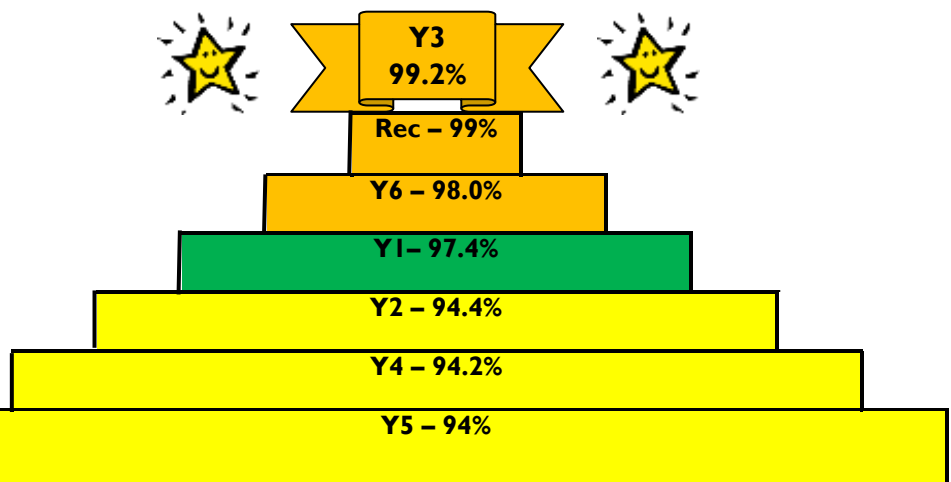

The children got to visit the Reception classroom and their parents/carers met the school staff on Tuesday evening. All of our Y6 pupils have attended transition days at their new high schools as they begin to prepare to move on from St. Stephen's in September. Y5 attended the Eucharistic Voices event at Liverpool Cathedral on Tuesday this week. The children represented our school proudly and sung beautifully. 	<h3 style="text-align: center;">School Uniform</h3> <p>As we near the end of the school year, I appreciate that people are looking ahead to next year and purchasing school uniforms. As of September, all pupils must wear sensible black, waterproof shoes for school. Trainers are not to be worn as they are not part of school uniform – they must only be worn for PE.</p> <p>Next year, pupils in Years 1-6 are to wear their PE kit into school on the day that they have their PE lesson. Pupils must wear a white t-shirt, dark shorts and pumps or trainers.
