## School Uniform

As we come to the end of the school year, I appreciate that people are looking ahead to next year and purchasing school uniforms. As of September, all pupils **must** wear sensible black, waterproof shoes for school. Trainers are **not** to be worn as they are not part of school uniform – they must only be worn for PE.

Next year, pupils in Years 1-6 are to wear their PE kit into school on the day that they have their PE lesson. Pupils must wear a white t-shirt, dark shorts and pumps or trainers. During winter months pupils may wear a plain black or navy tracksuit for PE to keep warm in case they work outside.
