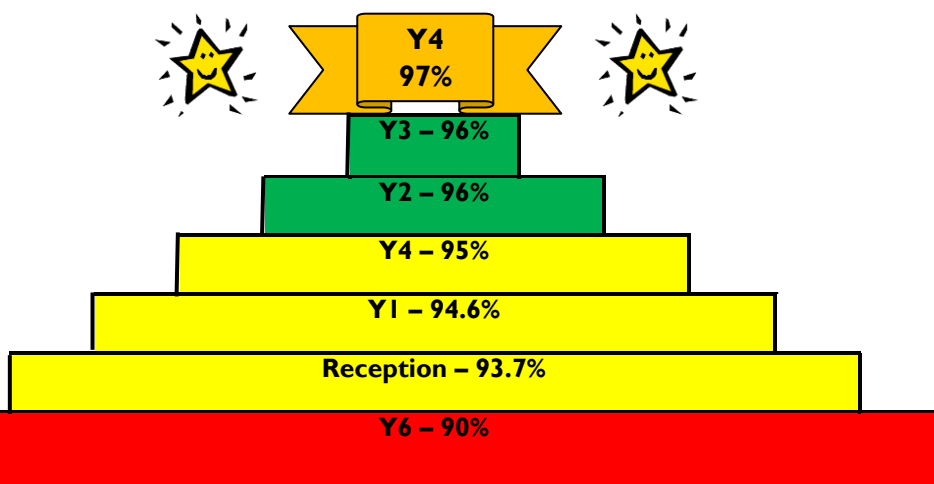

<p>School will be open from 8.45am on Friday 28th June as normal but children should arrive no later than 9.15am. The buses have been booked to leave school at 9.45am. We will then assemble on the lawns outside of the Town Hall at 10.40am to be ready to start our procession at 10.56am from Bank Park. Pupils will be supervised by school staff during the walk however parents/carers are welcome to walk with the parish if they wish to do so. Please let staff know if you are taking your child at the end of the walk from Warrington town centre or they are to return to school on the bus. We aim to be back at school at approximately 12.00pm where the children are to be collected. Please remember that school is closed in the afternoon.</p>	<p>We will be holding our annual school celebration day on Wednesday 26th June. The day will be packed with fun filled activities for the children and hopefully the weather will improve too so we can work and play outside! We will be having a special party box themed lunch. Please pay £2.30 via ParentPay if you normally pay for your lunch. Children in Reception, Years 1 and 2 do not need to make a payment. At 2pm, Fr John will be leading a special thanksgiving mass at church to end our day of celebration. Pupils in Y4 will receive their Holy Communion certificates at the mass and they are invited to wear their communion clothes to church for the mass. They may bring their outfits into school to get changed into after lunch. All parents/carers and families are very welcome to join us for mass at 2pm.</p>	<p>Over 60 of our pupils have received a letter from Mr Gosling about the Children's University Graduation which takes place on Wednesday 26th June at 5.30pm at St. Elphin's Church. This is in recognition of the hours the children have built up by attending after school clubs and being members of clubs in the wider community. School Meals	Sports Day	Early finish 26/7/19
<p>Warrington Borough Council have sent home a form with information on about changes to our school meals for children in our current Reception and Year 1 classes. The changes will come into effect as of September. Pupils in these classes are entitled to a free school meal. From September, WBC are asking families to opt in for a school meal each day for one term at a time. So if you sign up in September for your child to have a free dinner then they are now expected to have a meal each day until the end of December. There is not an option to change between packed lunch or hot dinner. Changes can only be made at the beginning of a new term.</p>	<p>We will be holding our annual Sports Day on Tuesday 9th July.</p> <p>Reception, Years 1 and 2 will race in the morning session from 9.30am onwards. Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 will race in the afternoon from 1.15pm onwards.</p> <p>Pupils are expected to be in full school PE kit and trainers on the day.</p> <p>Parents/carers and families are very welcome to come along and watch and join in the fun on the day. Refreshments such as strawberries and cream will be provided by our PTA.</p>	<p>ADVANCE NOTICE:</p> <p>Further to our survey conducted on Parents' Evening in March, our governors have agreed to trial an early finish on the last day of this half term as we break up for summer. Out of 114 parents surveyed, 100 were in favour of the trial and voted for a designated time slot to finish. Pupils will still have morning lessons and activities, lunch and playtimes with the intention of breaking up for the summer holidays at 1.30pm.
