

Please could you help us by keeping your child's Parentpay account topped up with sufficient money to cover any snacks or dinners that they may have. We send a reminder each Sunday night so why not just pop on to make sure there are sufficient funds. Dinners are £2.30 each (£11.50 for the full week) and snacks cost 18p for milk and 25p for all other items.

Headlice

Please note that we have had a number of cases of head lice in school. Head lice are tiny six-legged insects, grey/brown in colour and the eggs will be firmly attached to single hairs close to the scalp - the eggs are cream/brown in colour and the size of a sugar grain. Lotion and special combs are available from the chemist. Tea Tree Shampoo is particularly recommended for treatment and prevention of head lice. Children with asthma, eczema or psoriasis need to use a water-based lotion. Please do seek professional medical advice if you are unsure what products are suitable for your child.

As head lice are passed between children very easily, please check your child's head regularly and if lice are found, let school know. As soon as your child's hair is treated, they can come into school.
