

Book Swap

We are very excited to be introducing a "Book Swap" in school on **Friday 1 February**. Books are such a great resource but often, we read a book a few times and it is then put on a book shelf to gather dust. We thought it would be great if children could bring in a book that is age appropriate and in good condition (but remember this is a book that you are happy to give away!).

The book that is brought in will be swapped for one token which can later be exchanged for a book during the swap. If you wish to donate one additional book so that there is a wide variety of books that would be appreciated. Additional books however will not be exchanged for a token.

The books will be sorted into age groups and the swap will take place in the hall during the school day: the teachers will take children into the hall to swap their token for a new book and at the end of the day the children can take their new book home to read and share!

Please only send the book that you are donating in with your child on Friday 1 February.

No Nuts Please

Please could we ask that nut products are not sent into school. There are children with nut allergies and since this condition can be life threatening, we are asking all members of the school community for their help in minimising the risk to these children by:

- Avoiding giving children nuts or nut products in their packed lunches
- Avoiding giving nuts or nut products or snacks/bars containing nuts for break time snacks
- Avoiding supplying the school with cakes or food items containing nuts for birthday celebrations, sales or events
- Avoiding sending containers such as cereal boxes for DT / Art lessons into school which may have contained produce made with nuts

Many foods are labelled as 'may have been produced in a factory handling nuts and cannot be guaranteed to be nut free' but such items will be allowed in school as it would be unreasonable to expect these to be kept out of school. Thank you for your help in keeping our children safe and healthy.
