The Gospel of Luke

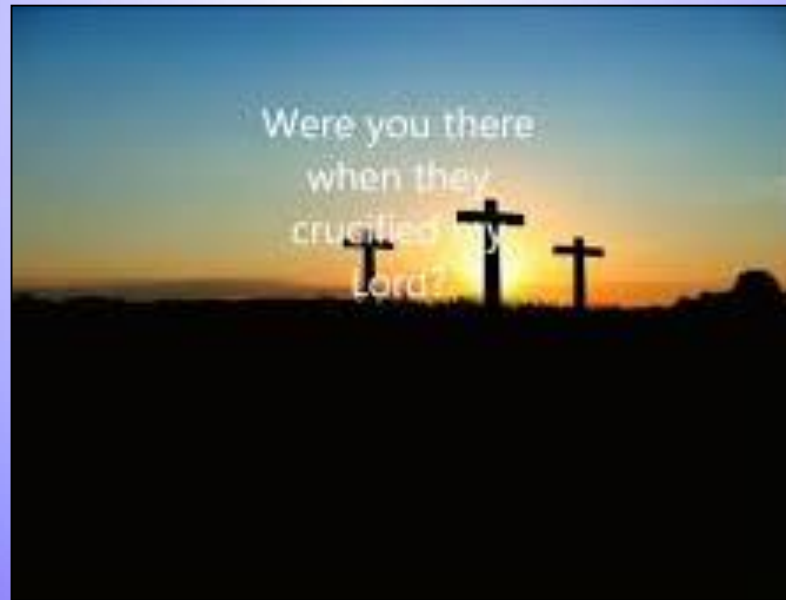
Chapter 23 Verses 33-34

Dear God,

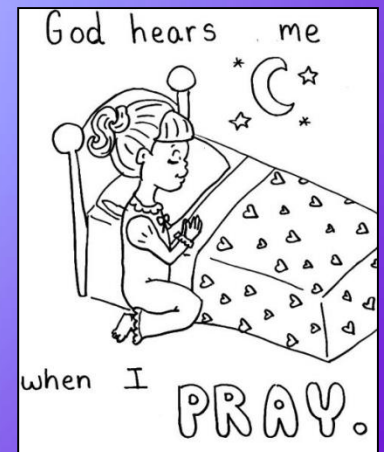
Now the busy day is done,
