St. John's has a passion for all sporting activities. We have a varied PE curriculum across both key stages including gymnastics, dance, football, hockey and netball/basketball.

KS1:

- Focus on ABC - agility, balance and co-ordination

KS2:

Cross Country:

Once a year in September/October we hold a KS2 Cross Country Festival on the field opposite the school. All children represent their colour team to earn points to hopefully win the Cross Country Cup. Year 3 & 4 run 400m (1 lap) and Year 5 & 6 run either 800m (2 laps) or 1200m (3 laps). The best 3 runners in the 3 lap race will win a medal! After this event our best runners from each category will represent the school in a local Cross Country Area Event.
