Tempest will be coming in on the morning of Wednesday 20th September 2017. Please ensure children are in full school uniform!

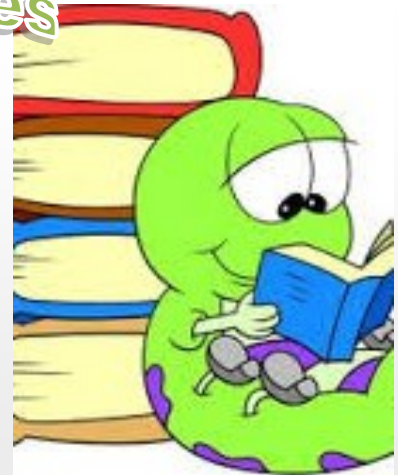
