The children have produced beautifully written evacuee letters, written a story about being in a shelter and experiencing the sounds of war and learning a WWII dance, crafts and producing a black and white information film.

Their work has reflected all the facts and learning that has taken place. It has been amazing to see how affected they have been about the history of peoples lives and how emotionally responsive they have become about the experiences during WWII.
