What is pulse?

In a piece of music there is a steady beat called a **pulse**. It is like a heartbeat that keeps beating throughout. We can tap along to different pieces of music and find the pulse.



Rhythm is how we organise different lengths of sounds.

It can be described as a pattern of short and long sounds.

Listen to your favourite music and see if you can find the pulse and rhythm.
