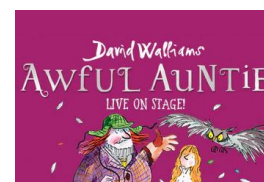
Gentle Reminder...

Early Years

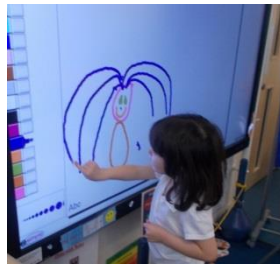
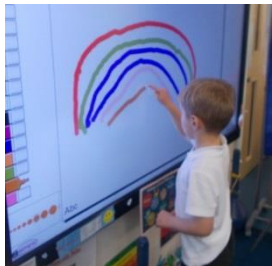
We have been dressing up for Diwali and acting out the story of Rama and Sita. We had mendhi patterns on our hands too!
