Dear Parents

Welcome back to the Autumn Term. I hope you all had a good Summer.

Our building works have been very successful this Summer and we are delighted at Trannack to welcome the pupils back to wonderful new classrooms. I think you will all agree, when you see them, how fresh, light, airy and spacious they are. All air conditioned too!

The contractors have worked tirelessly all Summer to ensure they are ready in time. Like any building works there have been a few unanticipated issues which they have overcome well. For example, you will notice the ramps to the classes are considerably wider than before to comply with new building regulations. Additionally, the whole building had to be lower to ensure the gradient of the ramps was compliant. This has meant that Praa Sands outdoor area had to be altered to ensure it is level with the classroom. The short length of time to complete this project is exceptional and yet we are ready to welcome the pupils back to the classes for the first day of term.

Some work outside the building still needs to be completed. Praa Sands and Portreath outdoor areas need to be completed. There is also a small space to the back of Godrevy class which will be made into an area accessible for pupils. Some of the windows have temporary screens as building regulations specify certain windows need to be replaced. The ramps to the classes have temporary wooden handrails which will be replaced with permanent steel rails. The old shed, which used to be positioned by the back porch, has been removed to allow a better outlook from the classes and more playground space. The aim is that this area will be made into a quiet seated area. These are all in hand and will be completed as soon as possible.

I am sure you will join me in thanking all the staff who worked extremely hard at the end of the Summer Term to prepare for the building works and also in the first week of the Autumn Term to ensure the school is ready for pupils to return on Monday. As usual, they have all gone over and above what is expected to ensure the very best for the pupils.

I am sure you will all be keen to have a look at the new classes. They will be open at the end of the day at 3:15pm for parents to view before pupils go home. We ask that you allow us the morning to welcome the pupils and settle them into their new classes as we are sure they will be very excited. Please be aware that classes will be awaiting finishing touches such as display boards and items of furniture.

Thank you in advance for your understanding and patience whilst the project is finished. In the meantime I hope the pupils enjoy their new space.
